

## **Nine Questions To Ask Your Dentist.**

1. Does the dentist use a digital X-ray system? Digital X-rays produce 90% less radiation than old analog X-ray systems.
2. Does the dentist use Septocaine for anesthetic? Lidocaine is extremely toxic (carcinogenic) and blocks lymphs in the retro-molar space, compounding infection in multiple teeth.
3. Does the dentist use a rubber dam while extracting amalgam fillings?
4. Does the dentist use an exhaust, placed at the mouth area while removing amalgams?
5. Does the dentist have medical grade air fed to the nasal passage while removing amalgams.
6. Does the dentist use dye-staining to identify infection in the teeth? X-ray will display approximately, only 30% of dental infection, regardless if digital or old analog X-ray system.
7. Does the dentist use a laser to disinfect the newly drilled tooth?
8. Does the dentist use low-fusing ceramic/hybrid resin blanks to form the inlay which is to replace the filling? This is a special non-toxic material with hardness – shock absorbing capacity to prevent cracking under maximum biting pressure.
9. Does the dentist use a laser to permanently bond the new inlay?
